This Vestry Book contains St. Peter Parish records of Baptizms, marriages and other record notes. Notice that Wm son of Wm Pulliam is listed. I can not determine if these notes are complete, just know that other references are transcribed from these records, or so it appears.

This is on the same page as above, and shows James son of Wm Pulliam. Also Sarah daughter of David Patterson. It also make a record of "Boy" son of Wm Pulliam. The point here is how important it is to research the most original records as possible. I went through this entire articles pages and could not find any record to points to the mother of the children of William Pulliam at St. Peter's Parish in New Kent County Virginia. We believe that William Pulliam was married to Ann Pattison. This makes sense that there were Pattisons listed in the Vestry Records. The problem is finding records for the rest of the children. At this moment, I can not find a record for Thomas Obidiah Pulliam as being the son of William and Ann.

Also on the same page at the bottom is listed Ann Daughter of Wm Pulliam. It is believed that this Ann Pulliam married William Sandidge about 1723. There is a lot of records about this couple. Did not find anything in regards to any other children of William Pulliam.
